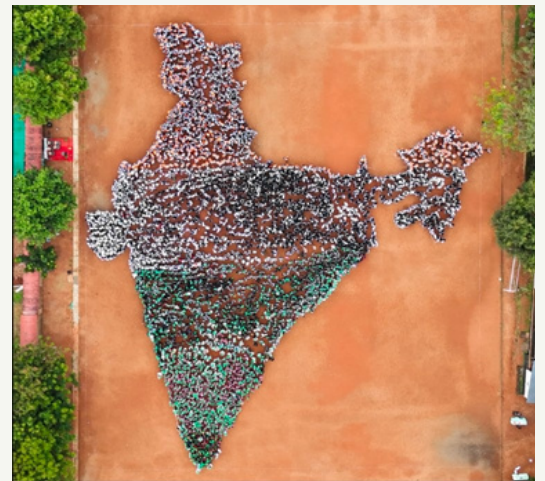
REJOICE IN TRIUMPH : THRIVING WITH NABET ACCREDITATION

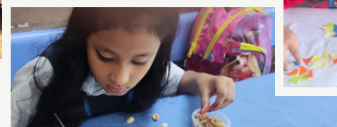
Celebrating National Sports Day with Enthusiasm
