GRADE 9 STUDENTS EMBARK ON AN ENHANCING FIELD TRIP TO OOTY

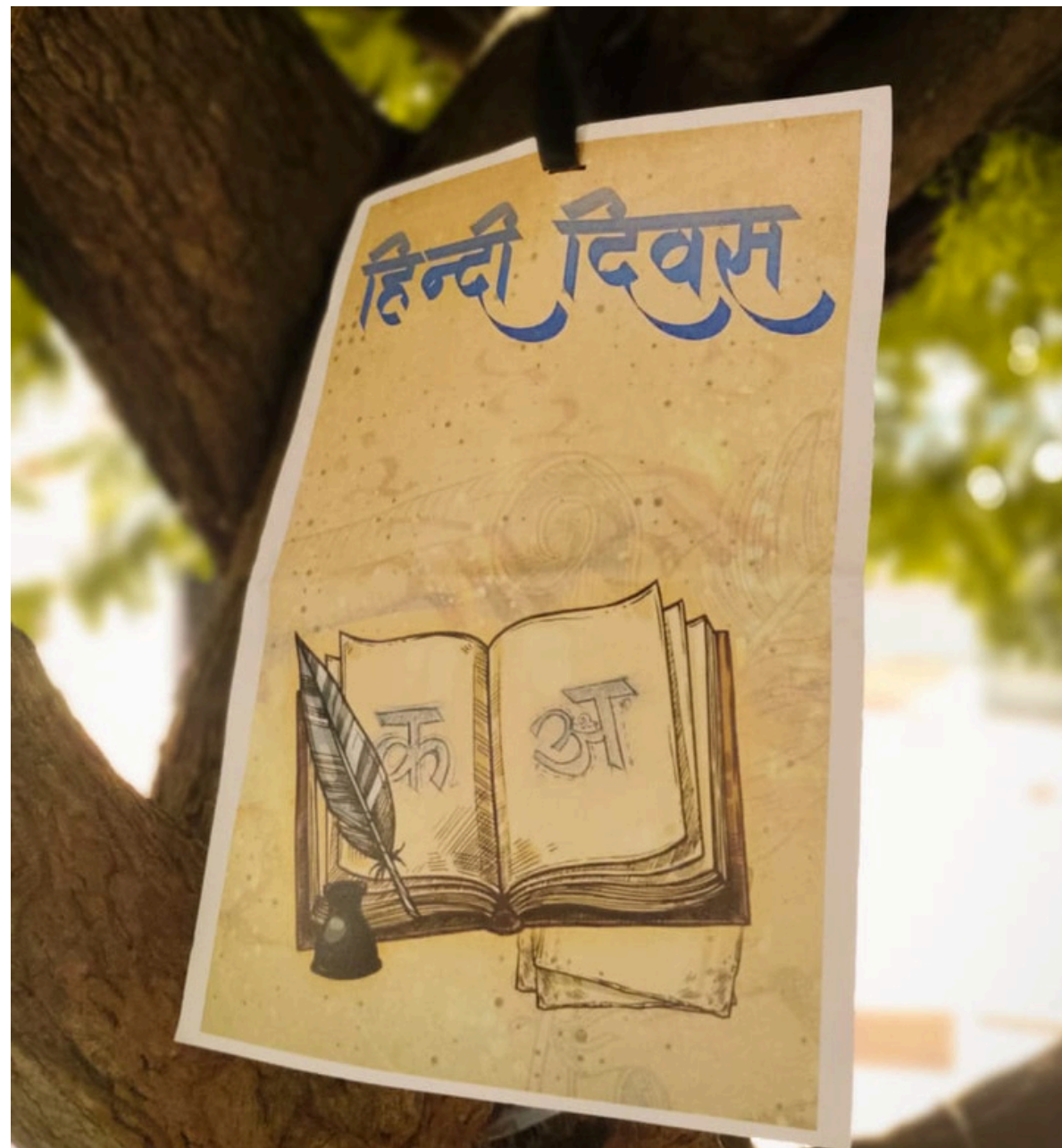

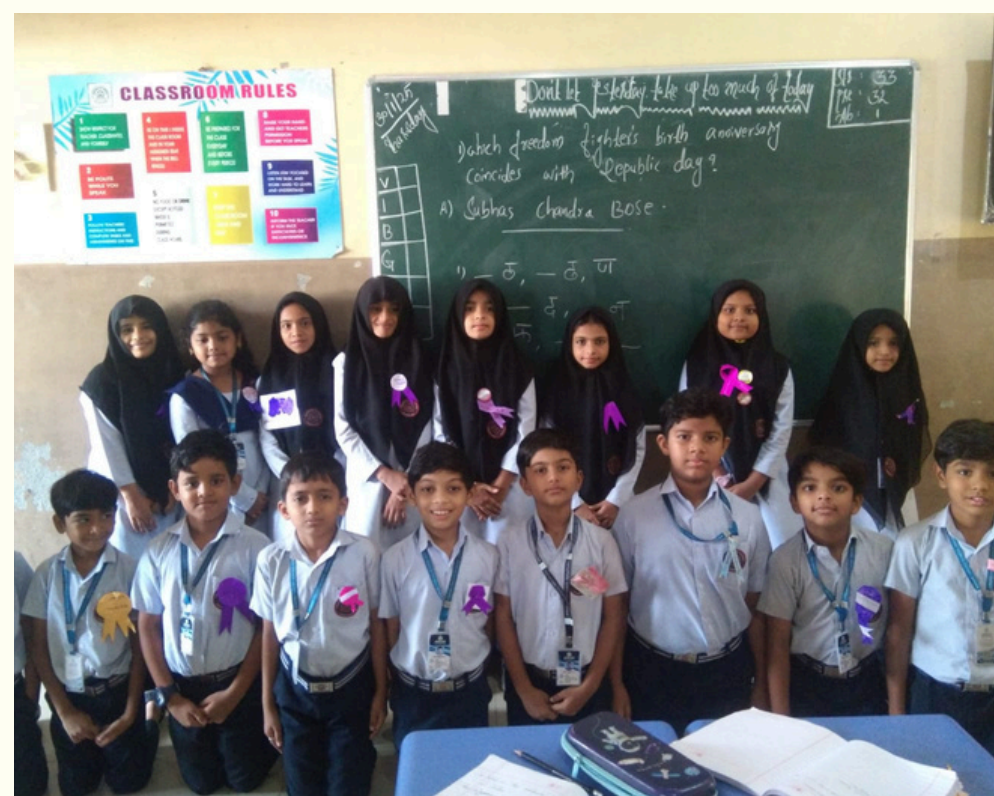
